



The winners of the GL Award for Young Professionals 2008

We would like to thank all participants for submitting their scientific papers for this year's GL Award for Young Professionals. As a result of intensive consultation, the jury has come to a unanimous decision, and we are pleased to announce the winners. Due to the quality of this year's entries, we have awarded two papers a third place. And the winner of the GL Award for Young Professionals 2008 is

1st Prize and with it a prize of 5,000 € for the topic "Entwicklung eines Brennstoffverbrauch-Überwachungssystems", written by Georg Eljardt, Technische Universität Hamburg-Harburg

Within his Diploma Thesis, Mister Eljardt has developed a programme, which aims to determine the optimal trim during service on board for deviating loading conditions. He demonstrated in superior quality, how to save fuel by consequently using the programme within a complex system, and thus contributing to environmental protection.

2nd Prize and with it a prize of 2,500 € for the topic "Energetische Analyse eines Containerschiffs mit Kühlcontainerstellplätzen mit Hilfe eines Simulationsmodells", written by Felix Frederik Oehme, Technische Universität Hamburg-Harburg

3rd Prize (1) and with it a prize of 1,000 € for the topic "Innovative Marine Propulsion System", written by Georgios Manousakis, Newcastle University

3rd Prize (2) and with it a prize of 1,000 € for the topic "Integration of CAD and CFD for the Hydrodynamic Design of Appendages in Viscous Flow", written by Mattia Brenner, Technische Universität Berlin
